## SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

- Mark Oppelt with O'Neill Conrad Oppelt gave a Schematic Update on the new elementary school design.
- Monty Howard with Marmon Mok gave a Schematic Update on the Clemens and Dobie Science wings as well as the HVAC renovations at both campuses.
- Consultant Luis Faraklas gave the Board a Preliminary Foundation Assessment Report on Wilder Intermediate School.
- SCUCISD Director of Facilities and Construction Wade Hawkins gave a brief construction and bond update report. He showed the Board photos of the progress at each construction site and of the future-build sites.
- SCUCISD Director of Technology Stan Hall gave a report to the Board about the Technology Department. He explained the organizational structure of the department, current initiatives and future projects such as installing security software and equipment at campuses to screen visitors and the installation of Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) telephone systems. He also reported that 5,000 accounts have been set up through Parent Connection, which gives parents access to their children's grades and attendance records.
