Spanish 1 Pre-AP- This accelerated course gives a firm linguistic foundation for the dedicated student who will eventually take the respective AP exam in his/her senior year, with emphasis to develop receptive (listening, reading) and productive (speaking, writing) skills, as well as gain productive (speaking, writing) skills, as well as gain insight into Hispanic Cultures through classroom activities and exercises that emphasize proficiency.

Class Expectations:
