The following are explanatory notes regarding the SCUCISD Facility Master Plan

ROSE GARDEN ES REPLACEMENT/ EXPANSION \$38 mil	 ROSE GARDEN ES REPLACEMENT/EXPANSION With the addition of Cibolo Valley Elementary (Bond 2013), SCUC currently has 8 elementary campuses in use. The next elementary will be a replacement campus for Rose Garden Elementary and will be built on district property near Corbett Junior High (FM 1518). Will follow the prototype design of Cibolo Valley Elementary. Campus is estimated to be 155,000 square feet and will increase design capacity from 484 to 990 students.
CLEMENS RENOVATION/ EXPANSION \$72 mil-Clemens HS	 CLEMENS RENOVATION/EXPANSION This project will be a combination of expansion of square footage and renovation of existing space to meet current educational/industry standards. Will increase design capacity from 2230 to 3300 students.
BOND CONTINGENCY \$10 mil	BOND CONTINGENCY Unforeseen issues with bond projects. Contingency dollars may be used toward any project proposed on the 2016 bond proposition, to include land purchase and/or design of future bond projects consistent with ten year Facility Master Plan.
HVAC REPLACEMENT \$10 mil - Wilder Inter - Jordan Inter - Watts ES	HVAC REPLACEMENT Consistent with district long-range plans, HVAC replacements are scheduled to occur at Wilder Intermediate, Jordan Intermediate and Watts Elementary.
TECHNOLOGY INFRASTRUCTURE \$5 mil	TECHNOLOGY INFRASTRUCTURE • Improvements to district server and storage capacities. • Increase bandwidth for the digital learning environment and district operations.
TRANSPORTATION (Bus Purchases) \$2 mil	TRANSPORTATION (Bus Purchases) • Additional buses to accommodate student growth, special populations, inventory replacement, and extra-curricular activities.
