

NOTICE OF BOND ELECTION

TO THE RESIDENT QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE

SCHERTZ-CIBOLO-UNIVERSAL CITY INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT:

TAKE NOTICE that an election will be held in the SCHERTZ-CIBOLO-UNIVERSAL CITY INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT on the 11th day of May, 2013, in accordance with a resolution adopted by the Board of Trustees which is a part of this notice for all purposes and reads substantially as follows:

A RESOLUTION ordering a bond election to be held in the Schertz-Cibolo-Universal City Independent School District, making provision for the conduct of the election and resolving other matters incident and related to such election

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Schertz-Cibolo-Universal City Independent School District hereby finds that an election should be held to determine whether said governing body shall be authorized to issue bonds of said District in the amounts and for the purposes hereinafter identified; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE SCHERTZ-CIBOLO-UNIVERSAL CITY INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT:

SECTION 1: An election shall be held on the 11th day of May, 2013, in the Schertz-Cibolo-Universal City Independent School District, which date is seventy-one (71) or more days from the date of the adoption hereof, and is a uniform election date pursuant to Texas Election Code, Section 41.001, for the purpose of submitting the following measure:

PROPOSITION

“SHALL the Board of Trustees of the Schertz-Cibolo-Universal City Independent School District in Guadalupe and Bexar Counties, Texas be authorized to issue bonds of the District in the principal amount of \$92,000,000 for the construction, improvement, renovation, acquisition and equipment of school buildings in the District (including a new elementary school, an expansion of Steele High School, an expansion of Dobie Junior High School, technology infrastructure and HVAC replacement) and the purchase of necessary sites for school buildings, and the purchase of new school buses; and shall there be

pledged and levied, assessed and collected annually ad valorem taxes on all taxable property in the District sufficient, without limit as to rate or amount, to pay the principal of and interest on said bonds and the costs of any credit agreements executed in connection with the bonds; said bonds to mature serially or otherwise not more than forty (40) years from their date, to be issued in one or more series at any price or prices, and to bear interest at such rate or rates (fixed, floating, variable or otherwise and not to exceed the maximum rate permitted by law at the time of issuance of the bonds) as in its discretion the Board of Trustees shall determine?”

SECTION 2: The District shall be divided into three (3) election precincts for this election and the polling places designated for each election precinct are shown in **Exhibit A**, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as a part hereof for all purposes. The election officers and maximum number of clerks for each polling place shall be determined and appointed in accordance with the provisions of a contract for election services (the “Contract”) to be executed with the Guadalupe County Elections Administrator.

On election day, the polls shall be open from 7:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M.

SECTION 3: Early voting for this election shall be conducted Monday, April 29, 2013 through Tuesday, May 7, 2013 on each day, at the Guadalupe County Office Building, 1101 Elbel Road, Suite 7, Schertz, Texas, which is hereby designated the main early voting polling place (Mailing Address: 307 W. Court, Seguin, Texas 78155; Attention Sue Basham, Guadalupe County Elections Administrator/Voter Registrar). The main early voting place shall be open on April 29, 2013 through May 3, 2013 from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and on May 6, 2013 through May 7, 2013 from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Sue Basham, Guadalupe County Elections Administrator, is hereby appointed early voting clerk and shall appoint and designate deputy clerks at such early voting polling place in accordance with the Contract. For purposes of processing ballots cast in early voting, the election officers for the early voting ballot board for this election shall be appointed and designated in accordance with the provisions of the Contract.

SECTION 4: A voting system or systems meeting the standards and requirements of the Texas Election Code, as amended, is hereby adopted and approved for early voting by personal appearance and by mail and for election day voting.

Ballots shall be prepared in accordance with the Texas Election Code, and permit electors to vote “FOR” or “AGAINST” the aforesaid measure which shall appear on the ballot substantially as follows:

PROPOSITION

“THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$92,000,000 FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, IMPROVEMENT, RENOVATION, ACQUISITION AND

EQUIPMENT OF SCHOOL BUILDINGS (INCLUDING A NEW ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, EXPANSION OF STEELE HIGH SCHOOL, EXPANSION OF DOBIE JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL, TECHNOLOGY INFRASTRUCTURE AND HVAC REPLACEMENT) AND NECESSARY SITES FOR SCHOOL BUILDINGS, THE PURCHASE OF NEW SCHOOL BUSES, AND THE LEVYING OF THE TAX IN PAYMENT THEREOF”

SECTION 5: All resident qualified electors of the District shall be permitted to vote at said election, and on the day of the election, such electors shall vote at the polling place designated for the School District Election Precinct in which they reside. This election shall be held and conducted in accordance with the Texas Election Code, except as modified by the provisions of the Texas Education Code, and to the extent required by law, all election materials and proceedings shall be printed in both English and Spanish.
