Know the Danger Zone

- Stay out of the Danger Zone at all times! No one should ever enter the Danger Zone unless they're absolutely sure the bus driver has given them permission to do so.
- **If you drop anything in the Danger Zone, leave it. Never stop to pick it up! If possible, speak with the bus driver about retrieving the item.**
- If you can touch the bus, you are too close!
- Using the 15 feet or "10 giant steps" rule is a good way to ID the the Danger Zone around the school bus, particularly when crossing in front of the bus

Know the Danger Zone (cont.)

- Always make sure you have the attention of the school bus driver when near the bus, approaching or leaving
- **No one should ever play around or near school buses or other motorized vehicles**
- Wait to approach the bus until it stops—NEVER approach it while it is moving
- Remember: If you cannot see the bus driver, the driver cannot see you!
- **Never walk or play behind any vehicle!**

Bullying Prevention 101

What is bullying?

Bullying is typically defined as when:

- A person is being hurt, harmed, or humiliated with words or behavior
- The behavior is repeated or there is a concern that it will be repeated
- The behavior is being done intentionally
- The person being hurt has a hard time stopping or preventing the behavior
- The hurtful behavior is carried out by those who have more power, such as students who are older, are physically bigger or stronger, have more social status, or form part of a group that singles out an individual

Who Is Involved in Bullying?

TARGET

Person who is being bullied

STUDENT WHO BULLIES

Person whose actions cause hurt or harm

WITNESS OR BYSTANDER

Person who sees or knows of the behavior

CAN SOMEONE BE INVOLVED IN MORE THAN ONE ROLE?

YES! It's often the case that the person being bullied, the person doing the bullying, and the person witnessing the bullying are not distinct parts. It's more common that students play multiple roles throughout the day.
