Levels\*: refer to the recommended order for stackable knowledge and skills a student should obtain as they progress through the sequence. They do not represent grade bands and there is flexibility in how districts can offer courses between levels. Local Implementation Considerations:

CTE Concentrator: a student who completes and passes at least two courses for two credits within a program of study.

CTE Completer: a student who completes and passes three or more CTE courses for four or more credits, including one state-determined level 3 or 4 (advanced or upper level) CTE course within a program of study.
