ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

1. Applicant must be a senior during this school year who attends and will graduate from Byron Steele High School
2. Applicant must have been on a Steele High School varsity team their senior year (including Managers & Trainers)
3. Applicant must have a minimum grade point average of 2.50
4. Applicant must enroll in a full-time, undergraduate course of study at an accredited US post-secondary institution.

Important Note:

Individuals who are already receiving any type of *full* academic and/or athletic scholarship, or college tuition waiver program are ineligible to receive a Knights All Sports Booster Club scholarship. (In this case an alternate scholarship candidate will be awarded the Scholarship.)

THE REQUIRED APPLICATION PROCESS INCLUDES:

1. A typed cover sheet with your name, address and phone number.
2. A minimum of a 500 word typed essay describing and including all of the following:
 - a) What your collegiate goals are for the next 4+ years
 - b) How athletics will be a part of those collegiate goals
 - c) Lastly, describe why you believe you are deserving of this scholarship to help achieve those goals
3. A completed typed scholarship application. (Applications can be obtained from the Counselor's Gallery, Mrs. Rubi Sanchez office, the Steele Athletics Office, Mrs. Kelli Brady or requested from the Knights All Sports Booster Club by emailing and requesting a copy at: KASBCtreasurer@gmail.com.)
4. A typed and signed recommendation letter from a Teacher or Coach explaining why they believe you are a qualified candidate to receive the KASBC scholarship.

Please drop off the completed application packet (cover sheet, essay, application, and recommendation letter to Kelli Brady in the Athletics office **no later than Monday, April 10, 2023**. All applications received after April 10, 2023 will not be considered. If you have any questions concerning the application process, please contact KASBCtreasurer@gmail.com. Applicants with incomplete or incorrect packets will be disqualified. All scholarships will be announced at the Steele High School Spring Awards ceremony in May 2023.

Scholarship Features:

KASBC Scholarship program will award each scholarship recipient with a \$1500.00 scholarship. KASBC will award a total of three (3) scholarships. Scholarships are awarded based on character, personal merit, academic standards, and commitment. The KASBC enforces our commitment to education and the scholarship program is designed to assist in the continuation of education beyond high school. A list of alternate scholarship recipients will also be chosen and will become the recipient winner if original chosen winners are ineligible.

How Scholarship recipients are chosen:

Judging is based on the essay, completed application listing accomplishments, awards, honors, community service, recommendation letter, and any other outstanding achievements in many areas of the student's life. Applicants must demonstrate accomplishments in leadership, community involvement, extracurricular activities and meaningful contribution to their school and/or community.

If the applicant is selected to receive a scholarship:

1. Selections will be announced at the award night for Steele High School in the Spring. Announcements for this award ceremony will be posted on Steele High School web page.
2. The selected applicants must provide an official acceptance letter from the school they will be planning to attend.
3. A check will be made payable only to the institution they will attend and is required to be used for Tuition, Room & Board (university sponsored housing at said institution).
