Pregnancy Related Services (PRS)

- A. Identification and intake documentation of pregnant students will be completed, verified, and filed by authorized SCUCISD personnel, the District Social Worker.
- B. The following services will be offered to each student that maybeeligible to receive PRS services. It is not required that each student use each and every service. The exception would be (CEHI).
 - *counseling services
 - *school services
 - *parenting information
 - *compensatory education homebound instruction (CEHI)
 - *social services co-ordination
 - *follow-up support services
 - *child care services referral
- C. The certified teachers erving as the CEHI instructor will maintain alogo fhome instruction during the days or weeks the student receives CEHI.
- D. Documentation of each student's participation in the PRS program will be on file with the **Schertz CiboloUniversal CityISDDepartment of Social Services Department, which is within the Student and Academic Services Department**. This documentation will include:
 - Verification of pregnancy
 - Pre-natal homebound service eligibility
 - Verification of delivery which includes a request for extension of postpartumperiod
 - SocialServicesreleaseofconfidentialinformation
 - Release to return to school
 - CEHIteacher'slogincludingdatesandtimes Copy of ARD and IEP, if applicable
 - PRS Entry date
 - Pregnancy Related Services CEHI Committee meeting documentation
 - PRS Exit date
