Dear Wilder Families,

This week principals, directors and educators across the district have been collaborating in order to develop and execute a plan that will allow our SCUC students to continue their learning, connect with their teachers and maintain a sense of safety and security during this difficult and unpredictable time. I am in awe of their commitment to serving our community in a way that will allow parents to support their child's education while keeping the emotional needs of the family as a priority. It is my privilege to work alongside such dedicated educators and support staff!

Below is information that I hope you will find helpful as we begin our remote learning journey with your family.

Medication Pick-Up

Nurse Sullivan reached out to parents regarding medication pick up needs. Most parents have already picked up their child's medication (*if they needed it*). Should you find you need to pick up your child's medication, please contact Nurse Sullivan at ksullivan@scuc.txed.net or (210) 619-4207. She will reach out to you and schedule a pick up time.

Social and Emotional Needs

Mrs. Martin, Wilder School Counselor, will be calling parents for children who received school support counseling services, to check in and determine what supports your child needs during this time. If at *any* time, your child needs support, please reach out to Mrs. Martin or let your child's Homeroom (5th Gr)/Advisory (6th Gr) Teacher know. *Please read the Remote Counseling with Mrs. Martin letter sent to Wilder Families for more information.*

Teacher Contact Information

To help parents, the main point of contact for general support/needs will be 5th Gr Homeroom and 6th Gr Advisory (3rd period) Teachers. All 5th Gr Homeroom and 6th Gr Advisory (3rd period) Teachers will be calling their Homeroom/Advisory parents to check in and make sure all questions and needs are answered/met no later than Tuesday, March 24th at 4:00 PM. If a teacher cannot reach you by phone, they will send you an email. **During remote learning, teachers will be calling from a Google Voice App or blocking their phone number. Please answer these calls.** (*For Google Voice phone calls, you will be asked to state your name and then you will be connected.*) After the first week, all 5th Gr Homeroom and 6th Gr Advisory (3rd period) Teachers will reach out to parents weekly via email or phone to check in with families. *At any time, a parent can always contact a specific content teacher directly.*

Technology Needs

The district is providing students in need with a Chromebook. Please go to the District Website and complete the Technology Survey. Technology check out times/locations will start next week. Parent will be contacted via email/phone to set a scheduled pick up time. Throughout the remote learning time, if your family should have a need for a device, please communicate to your child's Homeroom/Advisory Teacher so we can assist you.

Special Education/Dyslexia/Intervention Services

The teacher that supports a child will contact parents of students who receive Special Education, Dyslexia and Reading/Math Intervention. These students will still receive their accommodated/modified work and intervention activities from the appropriate support teacher.

At this time, we are awaiting guidance in regards to holding ARD/504 meetings. As we learn more, your child's support teacher will reach out to you to provide updated information.
