Dr. Clark Ealy, SCUC ISD Superintendent of Schools Professional Biography



The Schertz-Cibolo-Universal City ISD (SCUC ISD) Board of Trustees hired Clark C. Ealy, Ph.D., by unanimous vote, to become Superintendent of Schools, during a called meeting held on January 7, 2020. Dr. Ealy was selected as lone finalist for the position in December after an exhaustive search that included community and staff input.

Dr. Ealy has served as Superintendent of Schools for the College Station Independent School District (CSISD) since June of 2014. Ealy came to CSISD in 2000, having previously worked as a campus administrator and teacher/coach in districts in the Houston and Dallas areas. In his 20 years in CSISD, Ealy served in various capacities including Deputy Superintendent of Administrative Services.

Dr. Ealy is an advocate for public education, actively participating with the Texas Association of School Administrators, the Texas Public Accountability Consortium, Future Ready Superintendent Leadership Network and the Texas Fast Growth Schools Coalition.

Recognitions and accomplishments in CSISD during Dr. Ealy's tenure include:

- CSISD built and opened five schools in the past five years while adding \$6.6 million to the fund balance, a 22% increase.
- CSISD has been a National Advanced Placement (AP) Honor Roll District every year since 2014
- In 2016 the Brazos Valley African American Museum named Dr. Ealy as a Distinguished Community Honoree
- Texas A&M University's College of Education awarded Dr. Ealy the John R. Hoyle Award for Educational Leadership (2015) and the Dean's Roundtable Outstanding Educator Award (2014)

Dr. Ealy has a Bachelor of Science in Kinesiology from Texas A&M University, a Master of Education from Texas A&M-Commerce, and a Ph.D. in Educational Administration from Texas A&M University.

Dr. Ealy and his wife, Connie, have four children: Carole Anne (24), Robin (21), Jack (19) and Maggie (19). All four graduated from A&M Consolidated High School and attend or have attended Texas A&M University.
