# Arrival Procedures

\* Please be patient with all of our Eagles (staff and students)



\* Be kind to our neighbors, and do not block driveways.

\* Release students from cars all along the front and back of the building. Please do not wait to release at the front of the line.

## 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Car Line

\* Please do not drop students off in the front parking lot.

6<sup>th</sup> Grade Car Line

Dismissal Procedures

\* Please do not block driveways.

\* Be kind to your fellow car liners. Do not cut the line

5<sup>th</sup> Grade Car Line

\* Pull to the front of the line. Students will walk to cars.

\* LEFT turn out of the parking lot only.



# Arrival Info.

- Please release students along the line. (We can move the car line along MUCH faster if we unload 10 cars at one time.)
- Do not drop students off in the parking lot.
- Watch for students crossing the driveway.
- Be cautious of passing other cars in the car line, our Eagle staff, and anyone using the special needs parking spaces in the front of the building.
- Students can use either line, but 6<sup>th</sup> grade often find it easier to use the back car line.
- Be cautious of our neighborhood friends. Don't block driveways.

# Dismissal Info

- Pull ALL the way forward. Students will walk to cars.
  - Watch for walkers and bike riders.
  - Exit the car line with a LEFT turn only.
  - Do NOT block driveways.
