# Academics

- We offer regular and HONORS core classes, which are taught using the same state teks with the exception of math 7<sup>th</sup> and HONORS math 7<sup>th</sup>.
- The honors courses are an enriched faster paced, college-bound curriculum designed to challenge students at a higher level.
- Math 7<sup>th</sup> students are taught 7<sup>th</sup> grade teks.
- HONORS math 7<sup>th</sup> students are taught 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade teks to prepare students for HONORS algebra I in 8<sup>th</sup> grade.
  - If a student passes Honors math 7<sup>th</sup> they must go into Honors algebra I in 8<sup>th</sup> grade.



# Academics

- Applied READING AND MATH classes: WILL REPLACE AN ELECTIVE COURSE
- Tutoring is offered everyday either before or after school. Please see individual teacher's tutoring times. Tutoring must be prearranged with their teacher and have a pass from that teacher to their room.

- LATE WORK WILL BE ACCEPTED UP TO 3 DAYS LATE, WITH 10 POINTS BEING DEDUCTED FOR EACH DAY IT IS LATE ( 30 POINT DEDUCTION)
