


Accessing Student State Assessment Results

STEP 1 Go to <https://www.texasassessment.gov/families.html> (Students and Families)

STEP 2 Students and Families

- You may browse each Assessment Program to learn more about each assessment.
- Scroll down to “How to Help Prepare Your Child” and “View Your Child’s Test Results” sections



STEP 3 View Your Child’s Test Results

- Input your child’s information into “Family Portal” if you have their access code
- Click “**Sign On**” to view scores
- If you do not have your child’s access code, click on [How do I look up my access code?](#)

STEP 4 Enter your child’s first name, TSDS ID number, and DOB.

HINT: The TSDS ID number is a 10 digit state ID used in Education and testing. (no dashes)

HINT: There is a 10-character limit on the first name. For example, if the student’s first name is Christopher, it will need to be entered as “Christophe”

Click the blue “**Search**” button.

STEP 5 Your student’s Unique Access Code (6 characters) will appear with a message saying, “**Here is your access code**”. *Be sure to write down your access code for future use. You will use this code every year until they graduate from high school.*

STEP 6 Click the blue “**GO TO LOGIN**” button and enter the student’s DOB and First Name and click **SIGN ON** to see your child’s scores.

*Approaches, Meets or Masters are categories that indicate that your child has passed the STAAR exam. You can download the complete Detailed Report by clicking on the right button for each assessment. In addition, on the top right of the page you will find a **Resources** button where you will find information about the scores, STAAR test, how to help your child prepare, and FAQs. Click on these for more information.*
