<b>Duodenectomy</b>	<b>surgical removal of all or part of the duodenum</b>
<b>Dysuria</b>	<b>difficult or painful urination</b>
<b>Dyspepsia</b>	<b>difficult digestion</b>
<b>Dysphagia</b>	<b>difficult or painful swallowing</b>
<b>Electrocardiogram</b>	<b>recording of electrical activity in the heart</b>
<b>Encephalitis</b>	<b>inflammation of the brain</b>
<b>Erythrocyte</b>	<b>red blood cell</b>
<b>Gastritis</b>	<b>inflammation of the stomach</b>
<b>Genitourinary</b>	<b>organs of reproductive and urinary systems</b>
<b>Gerontology</b>	<b>study of the elderly</b>
<b>Gingivitis</b>	<b>inflammation of the gums</b>
<b>Glycemia</b>	<b>sugar in the blood</b>
<b>Hematology</b>	<b>study of the blood</b>
<b>Hematuria</b>	<b>blood in the urine</b>
<b>Hemiparesis</b>	<b>paralysis on one side of the body</b>
<b>Hepatitis</b>	<b>inflammation of the liver</b>
<b>Homeostasis</b>	<b>maintaining a constant level</b>
<b>Hypotension</b>	<b>low blood pressure</b>
<b>Hysterectomy</b>	<b>surgical removal of the uterus</b>
<b>Ileostomy</b>	<b>creating an artificial opening into the ileum</b>
