The Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) and Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief II and III (ESSER II and III) grants are now available for district application. In accordance with board policy CBB (Legal) and in our efforts to maintain fiscal transparency, if the district receives more than \$5,000 in block grant funds to be used as the district determines is appropriate, a public hearing with public comment on the needs and or uses of the grant funds must be provided.
Since ESSA funds for the 2021-2022 school year and ESSER II and III funds will exceed the \$5,000 threshold, the information shared will provide an overview of the planned use of these funds for SCUC ISD. Following this information, an opportunity for Public Comment will be provided.
